



## **How to Renew Your Certification**

LEAD and non-assessment requirements are met. ABFAS will renew your certificate for 10 years, and you will receive an updated label for your framed certificate, indicating that your ABFAS Board Certification is valid for an additional 10-year period. Please note: Diplomates who hold lifetime certification do not need to meet the LEAD performance requirement.

As a reminder, to maintain active board certification, you also must meet non-assessment requirements. ABFAS conducts random audits and may request documentation

for these requirements at any time. **View LEAD Requirements**






